One of my missions while there was to record eight sessions for "Ray of Hope" (Asha Di Kiran) in the Punjabi language. It now appears that Punjabi is the 4th largest spoken language in Canada. The recordings were a great success and I believe God has anointed those messages to reach His children.

That next Sunday morning I was picked up by Pastor George Bradley of Liberty Christian Assembly Church. After driving in the - 40° weather and raging snow storm, we arrived in the city of Red Deer. Pastor George apologized for the weather but reaffirmed the goodness of our God to show Himself strong. I was amazed at the expectation of the people who also endured the sub-zero temperatures and storm to receive something from the Lord. Once again, God did as He promised! The first man to be healed was partially deaf and wore hearing aids. Notice I said "wore", that's because he no longer needs them! Praise the Lord!
